

Christopher Weber is a retired instrumental music teacher, where he taught for Union-Endicott Schools in Endicott, NY 1979 to 2009. Chris directed the jazz ensemble program at Broome County Community College from 1997 – 2007 as well. He holds a BS degree in Music Education from Keene State College, and a Masters degree in Music Education from Ithaca College.

He is active as a conductor/performer on trumpet throughout New York State. Chris regularly plays trumpet with a variety of musical organizations. For many years Chris has played



trumpet in back up bands for such performers as Frankie Valli & The 4 Seasons, Natalie Cole, Kenny Rogers, The Temptations, The Four Tops, Tony Bennett, Tom Jones, Engelbert Humperdinck, Liberace, Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey Circus and recently for the National Touring Company of the Broadway musical "Chicago". He is a former President of the New York State Unit of The International Association of Jazz Educators. Chris lives with his wife Martha at their home in Owego, New York.

OCMEA HIGH SCHOOL JAZZ CONDUCTOR




Since 2008, saxophonist/ composer/ arranger Mike Titlebaum has been Director of Jazz Studies at Ithaca Collegein the Finger Lakes region of New York, where he directs large jazz ensembles, coaches small combos, teaches jazz saxophone and courses in jazz improvisation, repertoire, arranging, pedagogy and history. He is the founding member of the Ithaca Jazz Quartet and the creator of the Ithaca College Jazz Ensemble composition contest and the Ithaca All Star Jazz Invitational for aspiring high school jazz musicians.

He played in many of New York's world famous musical venues, including the Blue Note, Smalls, Augies, Fez/Time Café and the infamous CBGB's as well as the pit orchestra of the Broadway musical "Cats." He has performed with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, the Binghamton Philharmonic Orchestra, and with dozens of internationally recognized artists and groups. He has published numerous compositions and arrangements through Lorenz (Heritage Jazz Works), Advance Music, and GIA Publications. He earned his BM in Saxophone Performance from the Eastman School of Music in 1991, as well as the coveted Performer's Certificate in Saxophone. He received his MM in 1992 from Eastman in Jazz and Contemporary Media.
