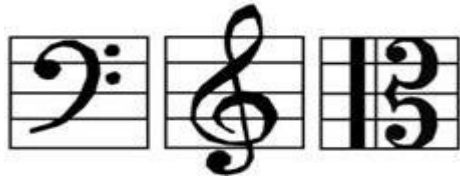

OCMEA HIGH SCHOOL BAND CONDUCTOR

Mr. Norman Wanzer, a graduate of the Eastman School of Music, retired after 33 years of teaching instrumental music at Baldwinsville Central Schools in Baldwinsville NY. During his tenure he taught all levels of instrumental music, orchestration and music history. He began the jazz program, annual musical and the competitive marching band. Mr. Wanzer has conducted musicals for the school, Theater Guild and Oswego State College. He is currently conducting the Lafayette Concert Band doing more than fifteen concerts a year. As a performer Mr. Wanzer has performed with the American Brass Band, Skaneateles Brass Ensemble, Syracuse University Brass Ensemble and the Northern Symphonic Winds on euphonium. He has done pit work on woodwinds and brass for many musicals in the area. During his tenure with the Onondaga Civic Symphony Mr. Wanzer performed "A Mozart Concerto" in memory of Professor W. Everett Gates, doing the first movement of the Flute Concerto, second movement of the Clarinet Concerto and the third movement of the Bassoon Concerto, on the appropriate instruments. As a founding member, Mr. Wanzer has performed with the Central Winds wind ensemble on euphonium, bass trombone, baritone sax and oboe; and for the last 15 years has been principal bassoon. The Central Winds have performed at multiple NYSSMA Conferences, NYSBDA Conferences and the Mid-West Conference. Mr. Wanzer maintains an active conducting and performing schedule.

Rae Jean Teeter has been the Director of Vocal Music at Guilderland High School since 1995. While at Guilderland she has developed a choral curriculum that has been recognized throughout the state for its excellence in performance and in the use of Music Learning Theory and Laban Movement Theory to develop the aural skills and total musicianship of her singers. Mrs. Teeter received her bachelor's degree from the Eastman School of Music where she studied with Donald Neuen and her master's degree from The College of Saint Rose. She has done extensive post graduate work at the Westminster Choir College where she has studied with such notable choral directors as James Jordan, Bruce Chamberlain, and Weston Nobel. Mrs. Teeter served as the NYACDA High School Repertoire and Standards chairperson from 2005-2008 and is a contributing author for "Teaching Music Through Performance in Choir Vol. 2" published by GIA music. Rae Jean has been a guest conductor for many all-county, regional and area all-state choruses and has presented sessions for ACDA, GIML and MENC at both the state and divisional levels speaking on the development of the male voice and methods for cultivating excellent aural skills in choral singers. While many of her alumni go on to pursue music as a career, she continues to work toward cultivating an atmosphere where her students will go on to become life-long singers and advocates for the importance of choral singing.

OCMEA HIGH SCHOOL ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

Julie Ribchinsky is a Professor of Music at Central Connecticut State University, where she has been a full time faculty member since 1978. She is also a visiting teacher of cello and ensemble at Wesleyan University. Professor Ribchinsky, an active performer, is a founding member of the Connecticut Trio-in-residence at CCSU. In addition to performances throughout the region, the Trio has recorded works by composer Ezra Laderman for Albany records. Concerts at New York's Weill Hall, Wave Hill and the Landon Gallery as well as at the Belding Theater in Hartford have been met with acclaim in reviews in the Strad Magazine and Hartford Courant. Ribchinsky has performed concerti with the New Britain Symphony, the Connecticut Valley Chamber Orchestra and CCSU Sinfonietta. As soloist, she regularly performs, collaborating in recitals and chamber works, most recently playing all three Bach Sonatas for Viola da Gamba with harpsichordist Linda Skernick at Connecticut College and presenting a lecture concert of Beethoven Sonatas at the Early Instrument Collection at Yale University.

Professor Ribchinsky teaches applied cello, chamber music and directs the CCSU Sinfonietta chamber orchestra. She actively promotes string playing through her role as past president of the state chapter of the American String Teachers Association (ASTA) and as a current member of its executive board. As a visiting teacher of cello at Wesleyan University, she directs the Wesleyan Cello Ensemble, which combined with CCSU students to perform a benefit concert for a newly built health clinic in Masooli, Uganda. Ribchinsky received fellowships to Tanglewood, Aspen and the Britten Pears School and is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music where she studied with Ronald Leonard, Allan Harris and Paul Katz.
