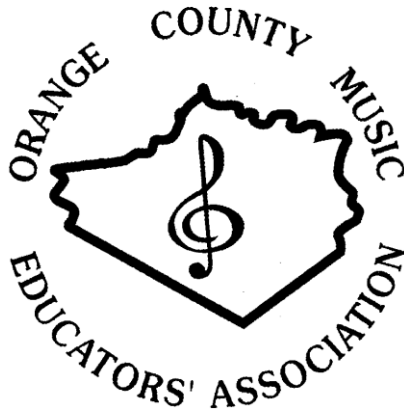

## ***OCMEA JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR***



**Dr. Alan Woy** retired from full-time teaching at the Crane School of Music, SUNY Potsdam in 2004, where he taught adjunct clarinet as Professor Emeritus for an additional four years. He has continued to lead an active musical life as a performer, teacher, and conductor in the Rochester area. As a faculty member at Crane since 1971, he taught studio clarinet, woodwind techniques, and conducting. He was also a chamber

music coach and band director for many years, most recently conducting the Crane Wind Ensemble. Dr. Woy currently teaches at the Eastman Community Music School and has a private studio. He is principal clarinet and a charter member of the Potsdam Clarinet Quartet, the Orchestra of Northern New York, and Northern Symphonic Winds. He was a member of the Potsdam Woodwind Quintet for 33 years until his retirement. A life-long interest in contemporary music resulted in the CD "Symbiotta: the clarinet music of Paul Steinberg." Recorded in 2000, the CD received critical acclaim in "The Clarinet." Since moving to the Rochester area, he has joined music educator wind ensembles in Rochester and Syracuse. Active as a guest soloist, clinician, and conductor, Dr. Woy is an All-State Adjudicator for the New York State School Music Association. He earned his Bachelor of Music in Performance from Illinois Wesleyan University (1967,) and his Master of Music in Performance (1969) and Doctor of Musical Arts (1979) from the University of Colorado.

## ***OCMEA JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL CHORUS CONDUCTOR***



**Dr. Susan J. Avery**, Associate Professor of Music Education at Ithaca College, was the former director of vocal ensembles and department chair of Waterloo High School for 24 years. She received her BM from the Eastman School of Music, MM from Ithaca College and a PhD from Eastman, where she was awarded the Eastman Graduate Teaching Assistant Prize for excellence in college teaching. Dr. Avery conducts

elementary, junior high and senior high honors, All-County and Area All-State Choruses throughout New York State; judges solo vocal and All-State Vocal Jazz as well as choral major organizations for the New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA); and gives clinics and workshops on the local, state and national levels in the field of music education. She will accompany this year's All-State Women's Chorus at the NYSSMA Winter Conference. Her research on adult rehearsal preferences was presented at the University of Wisconsin-Madison Lifelong Learning Symposium in April 2005, two posters sessions (for original research/best practice) were given at Society of Music Teacher Education in September 2005, a poster session on adult music preference was given at the 2006 NYSSMA Winter Conference, and the research presented at the Music and Lifelong Learning Symposium she hosted at Ithaca College in September 2007. Susan presented a session on Working with Adult Musicians at MENC's All-Eastern Conference in 2007 and will present at All-Eastern 2009 on Singing in Instrumental Settings. Susan provided choral experiences to adults in the New Horizons Music camp at Interlochen in summers of 2006 and 2007 and at the New Horizons camp at Ithaca College in summer 2008. Susan is currently investigating adult learning theories and music literacy and is a charter member of the newly formed North American Coalition for Community Music. She has published in *American Music Teacher*, *The School Music News*, *Music Educators' Journal* and contributed to MENC's Benchmarks in Action: A Guide to Standards-Based Assessment in Music. Susan presented original research at the Music and Lifelong Learning Symposium in Texas (October '09) and the ACDA Eastern Conference in Philadelphia (February '10).

## ***OCMEA Junior High School Band Conductor***



**Eric L. Hinton** is a native of Philadelphia, PA. He received his undergraduate and master's degrees from Northwestern University where he studied conducting and arranging with John P. Paynter, trumpet with Vincent Cichowicz and music education with Bennett Reimer and Don Owens. He received his PhD from the Birmingham Conservatoire in the United Kingdom where he studied conducting with Guy Woolfenden and Timothy Reynish. In addition, he served as visiting lecturer in conducting.

Prior to moving to the UK, Dr Hinton served for seven years as the Head of Winds and Brass at the John-F.-Kennedy-Schule, a

German-American bi-cultural, bilingual school in Berlin, Germany. Many of his former students have gone on to study music at prestigious conservatories and universities in Europe and the United States. While living in the United Kingdom, Dr.Hinton was an active conductor. His performances with the Birmingham Conservatoire Wind Orchestra have been broadcast on BBC Radio 3 as well as Lyric FM in Ireland. He was conductor and musical director of the Nottingham Symphonic Wind Orchestra and the Worcestershire Symphony Orchestra, which was founded by Edward Elgar in 1905. He was also associate conductor of the Central England Ensemble as well as founder and conductor of the Telford New Symphony Orchestra. He has conducted in France, Switzerland, Germany, Ireland and the Czech Republic.

Dr. Hinton is Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Susquehanna University where he conducts the Symphonic Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Stadium Band. He teaches trumpet and conducting as well as courses in brass instrument pedagogy and the history of literature of the wind orchestra. His professional affiliations include the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, College Band Directors National Association, Music Educators National Conference, Pennsylvania Music Educators National Association, International Trumpet Guild and Phi Mu Alpha. Dr. Hinton is in demand as a conductor and clinician and has appeared with ensembles throughout the United States. Most recently he conducted the Pennsylvania All-State Concert Band at the 2009 conference of the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association in Valley Forge, PA. His first book, *Conducting the Wind Orchestra: Meaning, Gesture and Expressive Potential* was published by Cambria Press in December, 2008.

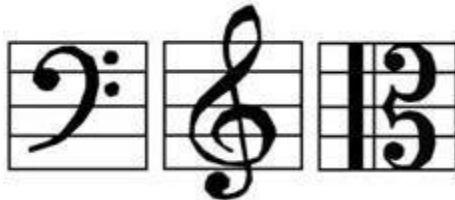
