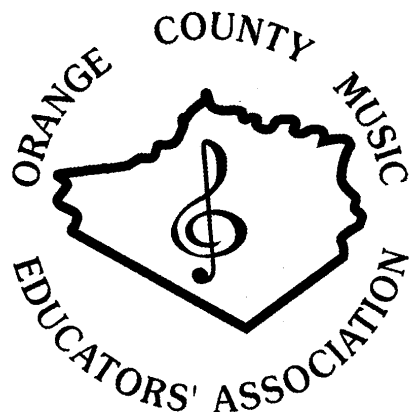

Christopher Fens began his teaching career in 2002 in Chesterfield County, Virginia where he was hired as the band director for Bailey Bridge Middle School. Under his leadership, the bands at BBMS have received numerous excellent and superior ratings at District Band Assessments and have won many awards at band assessment competitions.

Prior to his teaching, Christopher spent four years with the United States Marine Corps Band at Quantico, Virginia. After his service, he continued his education at Virginia Commonwealth University where he earned his Bachelor's Degree in 2000 (cum laude) and Master's Degree (magna cum laude) in 2002, both in Music Education with a concentration in conducting. As a graduate student, Christopher served as the teaching assistant to Dr. Terry Austin and received the VCU Outstanding Graduate Student Award upon his graduation.

Christopher was the conductor of the Chesterfield County Community Band from January 2000 to December 2004. In January 2002, he was selected as the conductor of the Fredericksburg Community Concert Band and still holds that position today. In 2008, he was selected to be the Band Director for the American Legion Boys State held at Radford University and was inducted into the Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity in 2009. He is currently a member of the Virginia Music Educators Association, The National Association for Music Education, the Phi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society, and the American Legion. He is an active adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor at all levels. In May 2012, Christopher was selected as the 2011-2012 Performing Arts Teacher of the Year for Bailey Bridge Middle School. He currently resides in Chesterfield County with his wife Amy and their children Meghan, Hannah, Kara, Madelyn, Matthew, and Callie.
