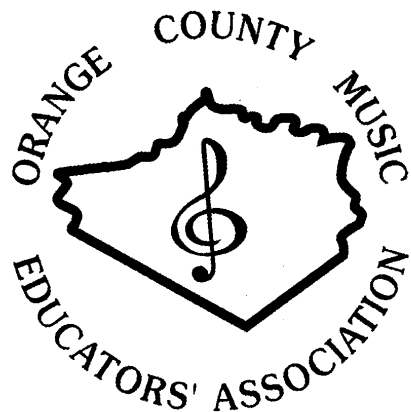

OCMEA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CHORUS A CONDUCTOR



Christa Braunreuther is an alumnus of the Crane School of Music at the State University of New York at Potsdam where she received a bachelor's of music degree in music education with a vocal concentration from the Crane School of Music. Christa studied voice under the instruction of Dr. Kathleen Allen and conducting under Dr. Rebecca Reames. She later earned her Master's Degree from the State University of New York at Stony Brook.

Christa is entering her tenth year at St. James Elementary School of the Smithtown Central School District. As an elementary music specialist, she teaches general music (K-5) and conducts the 5th grade choir. In addition, Christa coordinates and directs the St. James Singer's Club, a before-school club that prepares for outside of school performances and festivals. The St. James Singer's have received Superior ranking at the Long Island Music Festival three years in a row! Christa also directs the Broadway Bonanza Musical Revue at St. James Elementary. More than once, Christa acted as conductor for the annual Smithtown All-District Music Festival Chorus, where she worked with choral students from across the Smithtown school district.

This year marks the fifth year of Christa's involvement in the Long Island Children's Choir. She is the conductor/artistic director of the Prelude choir, which is made up of the youngest and beginning level singers. Similar to the St. James Singers, the LICC Prelude choir participates in community performances and service performances across the island. This "choir for a cause" is Christa's proudest achievement to date.

Christa is active in the music education community. She is currently the VP of Classroom Music for the Suffolk County Music Educators Association (SCMEA) and is a member of other organizations; NYSSMA, Long Island Association of the Orff-Schulwerk Association (recently completed Orff Level 1), and the American Choral Directors Association. These memberships keep Christa active in the music community and her teaching pedagogies current.

Most recently, Christa was appointed a two-week choral conducting position at the prestigious Usdan Summer Camp for the Creative and Performing Arts, where she directed two choirs made up of 2nd to 6th grade students and prepared them for a concert. Christa maintains a strong vocal studio out of her home in Smithtown and prepares students for NYSSMA solo festivals.

Harvey R. Boyer received both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from Ithaca College School of Music. For the past 20 years, he has taught elementary band at the Ontario Central School District. Over the course of his career, Mr. Boyer has been selected as a guest conductor and clinician in Chenango, Dutchess, Greene, Sullivan, and Ulster All-County festivals. His ensembles have received multiple Gold and Gold with Distinction

ratings at NYSSMA Majors festivals. Recently, his jazz ensembles have been featured in radio performances for WKZE 98.1 and WDST 100.1. They have also been featured at the Bearsville Theater.

Currently, Mr. Boyer is the Director of Education for the Phoenicia Festival of The Voice. He is also an assistant director/soloist of the choral ensemble Ars Choralis. Mr. Boyer is an avid performer and has been the featured guest tenor soloist with the Woodstock Chamber Orchestra, performing Handel's "Dettingen Te Deum". Additionally, Mr. Boyer enjoys performing with the ensembles Blue Gardenia, The Will Smith Trio, and D-Squared Blues Band.

Mr. Boyer is an active member of the Ulster County Music Educators Association, where he has held the post of Government Relations Chairperson for the last three years.

Randy Czosnyka is his twentieth year of teaching elementary and middle school orchestra. He has been the fifth and sixth grade orchestra director at Mill Middle School in the Williamsville Central School District for the past thirteen years. Before teaching in Williamsville, Mr. Czosnyka spent the previous seven years teaching elementary and middle school strings in the Ithaca City Schools

and Springville-Griffith Institute.

Mr. Czosnyka received his Bachelor of Music and Masters of Music Education from SUNY College at Fredonia. As a bass and cello player, he has performed in small ensembles in the Buffalo area and with the Amherst Symphony Orchestra and Orchard Park Symphony Orchestra where he has served as principal bassist for several seasons. He has guest conducted Elementary and Junior High Orchestras in Erie, Niagara and Monroe County over the past several years. Mr. Czosnyka serves as an adjudicator at NYSSMA Solo Festivals as well as various All-County solo festivals in Western New York and is a clinician specializing in music technology and low string pedagogy. John Armstrong holds a Bachelor's Degree from the Crane School of Music and a Master's Degree from Ithaca College. John is the former conductor of the Syracuse Vocal Ensemble, West Genesee High School choirs and Oswego High School choirs. He frequently appears as a guest conductor for All-County, Area All-State, festival, and honor choirs and serves as a clinician in seminars, workshops, and graduate courses

for music educators around the United States. John has appeared as a presenter and keynote speaker for state conferences, ACDA, and NafME. As Director of the American Music Literacy Association, John has worked extensively with hundreds of choral directors to raise music literacy standards with Bel Canto Solfeggio at all levels in schools, colleges and universities.

As a composer, John was the first-prize winner at the Ithaca College Choral Composition Contest and winner of the Iowa Choral Commissioning Competition. He has written commissioned works for a variety of school, church and college choirs, and a number of his original compositions have been premiered by the Drake University Chorus. John has choral works in print with BriLee Music and Subito Music. His book, "The Solo and Ensemble Singer", was published by Warner Bros, and "The Reading Choir Singer", like many of his choral works, is available directly from the Association.
