OCMEA JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR



William Stevens is an active performer and conductor throughout the Hudson Valley. He is one of the band and jazz band directors at Union Vale Middle School in the Arlington Central School District in LaGrange, NY, with a middle school band program of over 300 students. His ensembles have consistently received NYSSMA Major ratings of Gold and Gold with Distinction, as well as placing first in their division, first overall, and with ratings of Superior at Music in the Parks festivals.

He founded the jazz program at Union Vale Middle School, and it has grown to include two ensembles with around 70 students participating and has also placed first at Music in the Parks festivals with individual students earning soloist awards. William's professional conducting experience includes numerous musical productions with the Arlington High School Admiral Players; principal conductor of the Hudson Valley Saxophone Ensemble; and guest conductor for the Northern Dutchess Symphony where he led the New York State premiere of the Scott Routenberg *Concerto for Jazz Violin and Orchestra*. He was also chosen as a conducting finalist for the Woodstock Chamber Orchestra (WCO) and was reviewed by Leslie Gerber of Hudson Valley One: "I have never heard the WCO sound as good as it did during this concert.... Those of us who were in the audience were lucky to be there."

William has been sought after as an All-County conductor and has led groups in Tioga, Montgomery, Putnam, Orange, and Sullivan counties. He is currently the principal clarinetist for the Northern Dutchess Symphony Orchestra and the Greater Newburgh Symphony, and has performed in Europe and at Carnegie Hall with the New York Wind Symphony. William received his Bachelor of Music Education and Performance degree from SUNY Fredonia, and his Masters degree in Clarinet Performance from Ithaca College. William lives in Poughkeepsie, NY with his supportive husband Chris and their adorable pug Jake.

Dr. Lon Beery is the chorus director at Spry Middle School in Webster, New York, where he directs six choruses totaling 500 students. Dr. Beery has composed or arranged over 50 published choral pieces which appear in the catalogues of Alfred, BriLee, and others. His TTBB composition I Believe was performed by the U.S Army Chorus at President Ronald Reagan's internment service in California.

For his compositions, he has received several ASCAP Standard Awards. He has also written several articles which have appeared in the Choral Journal and the Music Educators Journal and has presented sessions at state, regional, and national conferences of ACDA and MENC. He currently serves as the Middle School Chair for New York ACDA.

Prior to returning to public school teaching, Dr. Beery served as Assistant Professor of Music Education at Syracuse University where he served as Chair of Music Education. At Syracuse University, Dr. Beery taught choral and general music methods courses and directed the SU Men's Glee Club. Beery has also taught Choral Arranging at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, NY. He is a frequent guest choral conductor, working especially with adolescent choruses. He has directed middle school honors choirs in Florida, New York, Pennsylvania and Texas.
