

Her research interests include children's responses during music listening, choral music education, empathetic leadership, teacher identity development, assessment, and reflective thinking. She is co-author

and -editor of Musical Experience in Our Lives: Things We Learn and Meanings We Make (2009) and Prelude to Music Education (2002) and has contributed chapters in several research and pedagogy texts and articles in professional journals. Kerchner is on the editorial board for the International Journal for Music Education: Practice journal. An active clinician, she has presented keynote addresses, research papers, and pedagogy workshops nationally and internationally at conferences in North and South America, Asia, Africa, and Europe. She is currently the chairperson of the Music in the Schools & Teacher Education Commission (MISTEC) of the International Society for Music Education (ISME). Kerchner also frequently serves as guest choral conductor for elementary, middle, and high school honors choral festivals.
