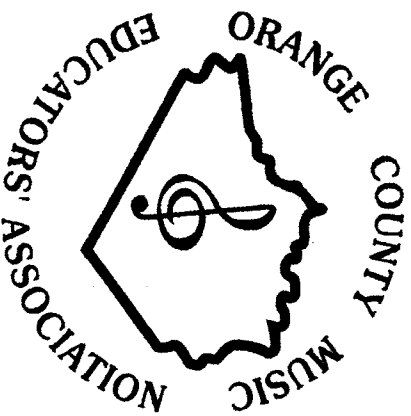

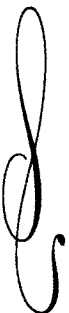

### OCMEA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CHORUS A CONDUCTOR



Scott Nathan Louis attended Binghamton University in Binghamton, New York, where he studied composition and music history with Edith Borroff from 1986-1990. In 1993 he received his Master's degree from Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where he studied with Nancy Galbraith and Leonardo Balada. Louis was a participant in the BML/Lehman Engle Music Theatre Workshop in New York City from 1999-2005. His body of work includes larger pieces for orchestra, jazz band, concert band, and choir, as well as chamber music, spanning a range of genres from concert music and oratorios to pop songs and musical theater. He has received commissions from the Children's Festival Chorus, the Children's Aid Society, the Rockland Conservatory of Music, and most recently from MusicWorks in association with Nyack High School in Nyack, New York. Louis had his debut at Carnegie Hall in New York in July 1996, when We Return Thanks, a piece based on a Seneca thanksgiving ritual, was performed. His most recent work is a choral symphony called "The Red Bandana", which tells the story of 9/11 through poetic verse and orchestral music.

Mrs. Kimberly Handman is a string teacher at LaGrange Middle School in the Arlington Central School District located in LaGrangeville, NY. In the summer she teaches fiddle and orchestra classes at Summer Strings located in Poughkeepsie, NY. From 2002-2009, Mrs.

Handman spent Saturday mornings conducting an orchestra at The Stringendo Orchestra School of the Hudson Valley. She has been a guest conductor for numerous regional events including the Vermont ASTA "Day for Strings" and the NYASTA String Institute. Recently, Mrs. Handman was a clinician at the 2015 New Jersey Music Educators Association state conference. She received her Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam and a Master's Degree in Music Education from the Hartt School at the University of Hartford.

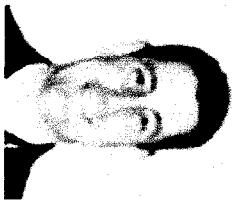

Currently, he is the band director at Bowling Green Elementary School in East Meadow, NY. Gary received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education from Hofstra University and a Master of Jazz and Commercial Music Degree from Five

Towns College. He is the director of the Nassau-Suffolk Performing Arts Youth Band and the founder and director of The Interplay Jazz Orchestra (their new album "Detour" recently debuted at #13 on the CMJ Jazz Charts) and also plays trumpet in the group. He is an active clinician, guest conducting several All-County and All-District Festivals as well as various reading sessions. His 5th Grade Band has won several awards including a Level 2 "Gold with Distinction" rating at the NYSSMA Majors Festival. He is co-author of several books including "The Prerequisites: A Sequential Method for Beginner Winds", "Foundations: 120 Chorales, Warm Ups, and Targeted Exercises for Band", and "Foundations for Orchestra". He also wrote "Five Pieces for First Year Band". (Pinnacle Music Press, Inc.) Mr. Henderson is a member of BMI. His song writing credits include music used for MTV's "Say What? Karaoke", the myNetworkTV soap opera "Desire", and even a Japanese game show! He has performed across the United States and most of Europe. In 1997, he was nominated for Instrumentalist of the Year as part of the Long Island Music Awards. He now lives in Yaphank, New York with his wife Christina and his son Anthony William.

Deborah A. Cunningham is a vocal and general music educator at Jamesville-Dewitt Middle School in Jamesville, NY, Organist and Cherub Choir Director at Christ Episcopal Church in Manlius, NY, part-time instructor in Music Education at Syracuse University, part-time instructor of music at Le Moyne College, and a certified Level I instructor for Green Lakes Music

Together. She holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Music Education, and a Master's degree in performance from Syracuse University, where she is currently pursuing a Ph.D. in Teaching and Curriculum. She has studied both Orff Schulwerk and Kodaly approaches to music education, is a Level I pedagogy instructor for the American Orff Schulwerk Association, and is formerly the associate director of the Syracuse Children's Chorus. In her capacity as an Orff Schulwerk Specialist and Choral Conductor, Deborah presents workshops across the United States and abroad for in-service and pre-service music educators, and frequently serves as guest conductor for music education organizations. In 2007 she was awarded the *Syracuse Symphony Musician's Award for Outstanding Music Educator* in the Classroom/General Music category. Deborah is co-author of the book *Travel On and On: Interdisciplinary Lessons on the Music of World Cultures*, with Dr. Elisa Dekaney, and is published in *Music Educators Journal* and *Update: Applications of Research in Music Education*. Active as a collaborative pianist in the Syracuse area, Ms. Cunningham has performed with the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Syracuse, Symphoria, the Syracuse Opera Company, the Skarateles Festival, the Syracuse Children's Chorus, and Civic Morning Musicals.
