He holds bachelor's degrees with honors in music education and biochemistry from Michigan State University, the Master of Music from Baylor University, and the Doctor of Musical Arts in conducting from the University of Texas at Austin where he

studied with Jerry Junkin. Dr. Ethington has been guest conductor at conferences of the College Band Directors National Association, the New York State School Music Association and the National Opera Association. He has published articles in the *Journal of the College Band Directors National Association* and the *World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles Journal*, and currently serves on the editorial board of the *WASBE Journal*. He has also been a regular contributor to the highly successful educational series *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* (GIA Publications). Dr. Ethington is Immediate Past President of the Big East Conference Band Directors Association, and has appeared as guest conductor and clinician throughout the United States, Western Europe and Australia.

She has attended the Aspen Musical Festival as a guest artist and her past principle teachers have been the late Beverley Peck Johnson from the Julliard School, as well as Diane Richardson, also from the Julliard School.

In 2005 Mrs. Williams was a guest conductor at the Senior High NYSMMA Area All State Music Festival and began teaching at Marist College in Poughkeepsie, NY first as an adjunct faculty member in 2006. In 2007 she became the Director of Choral Activities at Marist College. At Marist Mrs. Williams teaches music theory, music history, and choral conducting.
